Welcome:

Organize in June 1971, the object of this league is to promote and stimulate good fellowship and interest in golf at Kettle Moraine Golf Course and to enable its members to enjoy the spirit of intra and inter club competition.

Membership is limited to any man with an interest in the game of golf and may become a member by paying the required amount of dues, providing he is at least 18 years of age on/or before joining and entering competition.

The Kettle Moraine Men's Club season begins on the second Tuesday in April and continues thru to the second Tuesday in October, culminating with the "Bash" the following Sunday. Or as you will often hear, the Bash is held on the first Sunday following the second Tuesday in October.

Dues are \$140.00 and each year subject to revision. Dues include entry into all club events (unless otherwise noted) as well as dinner on the three dinner nights. All dues must be paid by the second Tuesday of April.

All golfers must have a USGA handicap to be eligible for tournaments and/or weekly events. New members may obtain a handicap by posting five 18-hole scores. It is the obligation of all members to post all 18-hole scores.

Each and every member of the Kettle Moraine Men's Club will try to seek out the new members, welcome them, and assist in any manner possible. If you have any questions, please ask an existing member.

Attached is a list of club events and general rules of the Tuesday Night Men's League.

TUESDAY NIGHT MEN'S LEAGUE

General Rules

I

1. Player shall abide by the U.S.G.A. rules and local rules.
2. All putts shall be holed out and counted.
3. Each player is required to put 25 cents into the 3-putt jug for each 3-putt he has in his round. This only pertains to the 9 holes of league play.
4. Each score card shall be signed by the scorer and attested by any playing partner or scores are invalid. Score card must also contain first and last names of each player. Cards must be left on the events table.
5. Men's Club rounds are to be played after 12:00 pm each Tuesday or earlier if approved by the Kettle Moraine Golf Course starter. A player's 1st round on the designated nine holes will count for his score that day.
6. Each player is responsible for posting his **adjusted** score.
7. Any violations of these rules shall be grounds for temporary or permanent expulsion from the Men's league.
8. Player's right of way - see starting time rules.

II

Starting Time Rules

The Pro Shop starter will be in charge of starting members on the Tee as members arrive for Tuesday golf. Making tee time reservations, in advance, is always a good idea. Cancelling a tee time, in advance, is greatly appreciated by the Golf Course. Failure could result in having to pay the Golf Course for an unused tee time, or may prevent an individual from the ability to make a reserved tee time.

Starter has the right to fill a foursome.

Men's Club will play will alternate front nine and back nine each week.

"Sudden Death in Match Play" players will have preference on the tee, but must leave the course at once when match ends.

III

Men's Club Events

1. **FLIGHTS:** The league is divided into four (4) flights (A. B. C. D.) based on handicap. Division of the flights is at the discretion of the Events Chairman.
2. **WEEKLY EVENTS:** Each week there will be four (4) events for each Flight. Events may include, but not limited to; Low Gross, Low Net, Long Drive, Closest to Pin, Least Putts, etc. There will be a listing of the weeks events on the events table in the club house.
3. **9 HOLE MATCH PLAY TOURNAMENT:** This is an optional event, but is included in the yearly dues. Divided by Flight, this is a handicapped event, the lowest handicaps, within the flight, will be paired against the highest handicaps within the flight. Winning player moves forward. Brackets will be posted mid to late May.
4. **18 HOLE MATCH PLAY TOURNAMENT:** This is an optional event, but is included in the yearly dues. Divided into five (5) flights, this is a scratch tournament where the lowest handicaps will be paired against the highest handicaps within the Flight. Winning player moves forward. Brackets will be posted by early June.

Match play Tournament Rules

- A. All matches must be finished by the posted expiration date. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
 - B. It is the responsibility of every player to arrange his match with his opponent. Failure could result in forfeit. If two players cannot arrange the match, the player who plays on the most Tuesday's will win the match.
 - C. Matches can be played at any time, on any day, on any golf course, providing both players are in agreement.
 - D. If a player is more than one-half hour late for a match, he shall forfeit the match, Unless both players agree on a new time.
 - E. If a match is not completed due to weather, it is up to the players if match will be continued or restarted.
5. **MEAL NIGHTS:** included in yearly dues. There will be three (3) meal nights on the second Tuesday in May, June and August.
 6. **YEAR END BASH:** Not included in yearly dues. This will be held on the first Sunday following the second Tuesday in October. It is a team scramble format with teams to be put together by the Tournament Committee.

7. TWO-MAN BEST BALL - Not included in yearly dues. Throughout the season, on a given Tuesday, the Special Events Chairman will hold a Two-Man Bestball Tournament. best ball is where the best score, between the 2 players, for each hole is used. This is a special event that does not affect normal Tuesday play, thus normal Tuesday events are played as well. Cost is \$10 per team. A player, if he chooses, can sign up with multiple partners. Scoring is handicapped, but players do not have to mark their scorecards any different than a normal Tuesday. SE Chairman will calculate a teams score. All money is returned, in cash, to winning teams. Number of places is determined by number of entries.

8. SHOOTOUT - not included in yearly dues, cost is \$5 or \$10 per player. Once or twice per year, mid-June thru mid-July, the Special Events Chairman will hold a shootout, starting promptly at 6 pm. Usually we have between 15 to 20 players (but it is not limited to that number). This is a handicapped event where everyone tees off on the starting hole and plays the hole together. Depending on the number of players, 1,2 or 3 high scores are eliminated and the remaining players move on. In case of tie scores, on a hole, a chip off among the players will take place. All money is returned in cash and based on the number of holes played.

9. CHICAGO TEAM - not included in yearly dues. Cost is \$5 per player, for the year. This event is where a player is required, based on his handicap, to earn a specific number of points, on the league 9, each week. Points are earned by getting bogeys, pars, birdies and eagles. Generally there are 8 teams and players get placed on a team by the Chicago Chairman. Each week, the player is required to post his scores on his teams Chicago Team sheet. The 3 highest point totals are taken for each team each week. Team with the highest accumulated point total, at the end of the season wins. All monies are returned, in cash, at the end of the season. All teams earn prize money, with the first place team receiving the most. Players share in the prize money is based on the number of scores they post on their teams Chicago sheet.

10. RED, WHITE, and BLUE TWO-MAN SCRAMBLE - not included in yearly dues. Cost is \$10 per player. On the Tuesday immediately before or after the 4TH of July, we hold Red, White, and Blue. A scramble is where both players tee off, select the best shot, both hit there next shot from that spot and continue this format until ball is holed. The RED, WHITE, and BLUE part is, on the first hole everyone tees off from the red tee markers (forward tees), white tees (middle) on the second hole and blue (back tees) on the third hole, the repeat this rotation for the remaining 6 holes. **There will not be normal weekly events on this day.**
